By Public Transport

As the office is located in the centre of Brussels, the best way to reach us is by train, metro or tram.

1 By train

From Central Station to the office is a 10-minute walk. Leave the station through Gallery Ravenstein, cross over rue Ravenstein / Ravensteinstraat, walk up the steps at rue Baron Horta / Baron Horta straat (with Bozar on your right), turn right into rue Royale / Koningstraat and walk to place Royale / Koningsplein. Make your way to the archway at the far left corner of the square, where rue de Namur / Naamsestraat begins. After a short climb you will find rue Brederode / Brederodestraat on your left. The office is on your right.

There are three main rail stations: Midi / Zuid (South); Centrale / Centraal (Central - within walking distance: see above) and Nord / Noord (North). All Eurostar trains and Thalys trains terminate at South Station. From South Station take a taxi to the office. Allow 20 minutes from South Station to the office, 30 minutes during rush hour. A single fare costs about 10 EUR.

2 By metro

The office is within 5 minutes' walk from Porte de Namur / Naamsepoort metro station (lines 2 & 6).

In the metro station you take the rue de Namur / Naamsestraat exit. When exiting you are at the beginning of the rue de Namur / Naamsestraat. rue Brederode / Brederodestraat is the third street on your right some 250 metres down the road. The office is on your right.

3 By tram

The closest tramline is line 92 and line 93.

You exit at tram stop "Royale/Koning" in rue de la Régence / Regentenstraat. 50 metres from the station you have place Royale / Koningsplein and here you take the street up at your right under an archway. This is rue de Namur / Naamsestraat and in this street you take after some 150 metre the first street on your left which is rue Brederode / Brederodestraat. The office is on your right.

4 By bus

Line 95 / 27 stops in rue de la Régence / Regentenstraat where you exit at bus stop "Royale/Koning". 50 metres from the station you have place Royale / Koningsplein and here you take the street up at your right under an archway. In rue de Namur / Naamsestraat you take after some 150 metres the first street on your left which is rue Brederode / Brederodestraat. The office is on your right side.

Line 22 / 54 stops in rue Ducale / Hertogenstraat (Ducale/Hertog bus stop). From here you walk through place du Trône / Troonplein along the wall of the Royale Palace and a very small park with a statue in the middle. After some 100 metres, you take the first street on your right which is rue Brederode / Brederodestraat and the office is almost at the end of the street on your left side.

The terminus for line 34 / 64 / 80 is at Porte de Namur / Naamsepoort. From there you cross the boulevard A. Max / A. Maxlaan at the roundabout to the left of the terminus. On the other side you walk down rue de Namur / Naamsestraat. rue Brederode / Brederodestraat is the third street on your right some 250 metres down the road. The office is on your right.

By car

rue de Brederode is a one-way street and is only accessible from place du Trône / Troonplein. Direct Access from rue de Namur / Naamsestraat is not possible.

The entrance to the garage which is for suppliers (4 spaces) and clients (8 spaces) is situated approximately 25 metres before the main entrance.

Nearest public car park

As we have limited parking space please be advised it is best to park your car in the nearest public parking some 5 minutes from the office: 'Les 2 portes', boulevard de Waterloo / Waterloolaan 2a, 1000 Brussels. This is also the GPS address. From here you take the exit "Porte de Namur / Naamsepoort". When exiting you turn to the right on boulevard de Waterloo / Waterloolaan and there you take after some 75 meters the second street on the left, rue de Namur / Naamsestraat. Rue de Brederode / Brederodestraat is the third street on your right some 250 metres down the road. The office is on your right.

Directions from Breda

From the E19 motorway, take the RING in the direction of "Namen - Luik / Namur - Liège" and follow the signs for "Brussel / Bruxelles" and briefly join the E40 motorway.

At the end of the E40 motorway, follow the signs for "Midi / Zuid" (not "Centre / Centrum") keeping to the left and exit the motorway through a short tunnel. After another tunnel on the inner ring road, exit to the right at place Montgomery / Montgomeryplein. On this large roundabout take the first exit but keep to the left and enter the tunnel marked "Centrum / Centre".

You exit the tunnel into rue de la Loi / Wetstraat. At the next big junction boulevard du Régent / Regentlaan turn left, and then keep to the right until you reach place du Trône / Troonplein. Turn right down the narrow street just after the statue of Leopold II on a horse. Some 50 meters further you enter rue Brederode / Brederodestraat. The office is on your left after the second corner.

Directions from Paris

From the E19 motorway, follow the signs for "Centre / Centrum" until the inner ring road. Turn right and follow the direction "Namur-Liège / Namen-Luik", use the tunnels and exit at "Porte de Namur / Naamsepoort".

Turn left into rue de Namur / Naamsestraat. Take the first street on the right (rue de la Pépinière / Boomkwekerijstraat).

At the end of the street turn left into rue Brederode / Brederodestraat. The office is at no. 13 on your left after the second corner.

Directions from Aachen

At the end of the E40 motorway in Brussels, follow the signs for "Midi / Zuid" (not "Centre / Centrum") keeping to the left and exit the motorway through a short tunnel. After another tunnel on the inner ring road, exit to the right at place Montgomery / Montgomeryplein. On this large roundabout take the first exit but keep to the left and enter the tunnel marked "Centre / Centrum".

You exit the tunnel into rue de la Loi / Wetstraat; at the next big junction boulevard du Régent / Regentlaan turn left, and then keep to the right until you reach place du Trône / Troonplein. Turn right down the narrow street just after the statue of Leopold II on a horse. At the corner you enter rue Brederode / Brederodestraat. Our building is no. 13 (left-hand side, second corner).

By plane

You arrive at Brussels National Airport (Zaventem). The easiest way to get to the office from here is by train or you can take a taxi.

There is a direct train from the airport to Central Station every 15 minutes. The journey only takes some 20 minutes.

From Central Station to the office is a 10-minute walk. Leave the station through Gallery Ravenstein, cross over rue Ravenstein, walk up the steps at rue Baron Horta / Baron Horta straat (with Bozar on your right), turn right into rue Royale / Koningstraat and walk to place Royale / Koningsplein. Make your way to the archway at the far left corner of the square, where rue de Namur / Naamsestraat begins. After a short climb you will find rue Brederode / Brederodestraat on your left. The office is on your right.

As for taxis, allow 30-40 minutes from Zaventem to the office, 1 hour during the rush hour. A single fare costs about 55 EUR.

By bike

Arriving at rue de Brederode/Brederodestraat you have to take the garage entrance. The bicycle parking space for 14 bikes is situated on the left side of the garage in a designated area.
